5 Proven And Effective Treatments For Acne Scarring



For some, getting rid of acne is only the first step. Next, you might find yourself dealing with healing the acne scars that remain. There are many types of acne scars, and some will diminish over time, and eventually disappear altogether. But some scarring is permanent, and won't go away on its own. If that's the case for you, it might take more drastic measures to deal with your problem. Here are five common [treatments for acne scarring](#), from mild to severe. Maybe one will be right for you.

Microdermabrasion treatment for acne scars

This is an exfoliation technique in which surface skin cells are removed, and the look of acne scars is diminished. Microdermabrasion is a very fast procedure which can be performed in your dermatologist's office in less than an hour. There's also no recovery time, so you won't be wearing bandages out of the dermatologist's office. The downside is that it can take several treatments before you begin to see noticeable results.

Microdermabrasion treatments cost around \$200 to \$300 each.

Chemical Peels acne scar treatment

Those with mild acne scarring will probably see good results from chemical peels, which can make scars less prominent. A chemical peel, a product that contains acid, is applied to your face, and then removed after a certain period of time. When the chemical peel is removed, the dead upper layers of your skin are removed with it.

A chemical peel treatment will cost about \$100 to \$300. Be prepared for it to take as many as 3 to 6 treatments for you to see the results you want.

Soft Tissue Fillers acne scarring treatment

With this treatment, collagen, or excess fat from another part of your body, is injected under the skin to fill in the scar. As a result, acne scarring will be less noticeable. The downside is that the treatments are temporary, so you'd have to get more injections periodically. The results of collagen injections, for example, last about 6 to 12

weeks.

On average, collagen injections cost about \$300 to \$400 per session. The average cost of fat injections is about \$1,000.

Dermabrasion acne scars treatment

During the dermabrasion procedure, a rotating wire brush is used to remove the top layer of your skin. It also removes surface acne scars, and makes deeper acne scars less visible and noticeable. If you have mild or moderate scarring, you should probably try other, less drastic treatments first. But, if your scarring is severe, dermabrasion might be right for you.

You should expect to pay between \$1,000 and 1,500 for dermabrasion.

Laser resurfacing for acne scars treatment

During laser resurfacing, a laser will be used to destroy your skin's out layer. At the same time, the layer of skin underneath will be heated. When that layer of skin starts to heal, new skin will begin to form. And you will be left with fewer, and less visible, acne scars.

The average cost of laser resurfacing is around \$2,000 to \$2,500.
