Are Dreams of an Acne Scars Cure Realistic?

If you are looking for an [acne scars cure](#), you probably will not be pleased with home treatments that are simply in place to reduce the appearance of acne scars. While those work great for a lot of people, if you are serious about getting the maximum possible improvement, you will want to go to the more serious procedures that can really eradicate those acne scars for good. That way, you will finally have the face that you have always wanted, and the acne scars will be a thing of the past.

How to cure acne scars

One method that is often seen as an acne scar cure is called punch excision. Punch excision is a surgical treatment that is used for deeper, more severe scars commonly referred to as “ice pick scars” or “boxcar scars”. A punch tool is used to excise the scars, with the edges of the skin being sutured together, resulting in a new mark that will heal over time, leaving nice, clear skin. A local anesthetic is applied before the procedure, but it is a relatively minor procedure that is used by many as a cure for acne scars.

Meanwhile, skin graft replacement can be added to punch excision treatments, as well. Instead of using a suturing technique, skin that is grafted from another area (often from behind your ear) is used to “fill in” the resulting dent. If there is a difference in the appearance of the skin used to graft the areas, it will disappear within a month or two with resurfacing treatments following the procedure.

Dermabrasion and microdermabrasion treatments are also very popular ways to cure acne scars. They do so by using a high-speed brush (or in the case of microdermabrasion, aluminum oxide crystals that pass through a vacuum tube of sorts) to remove surface skin, which reduces the appearance of scars or removes them altogether.

These treatments do not work as well on severe, deep scars and may not be advisable for those with darker skin tones, as they may cause changes in the appearance of your skin pigmentation.

These are just a few ways to find the [acne scars cure](#) that you are looking for. There are other acne scar cures (such as laser treatments and collagen injections) that can also be looked into. The best way to really narrow down the possibilities to one that is right for you is by speaking with your dermatologist. Then you'll be ready to tackle those acne scars, once and for all.
