# Using Laser Treatment For Keloid Scar Removal

If you have the presence of keloid scars on your skin, you probably have wondered exactly what it would take to have successful [keloid scar removal](#). While it is always advisable to give home remedies and even store-bought products a try, sometimes they will not work to the degree that you were expecting.

In that case, you may find that a surgical procedure such as a laser treatment can be the best way to go. With laser acne scar removal, many in your position have been able to kiss those disgusting keloid scars goodbye forever!

### **How keloid scar removal surgery works**

If you are intimidated by keloid laser treatment, you should not be. The simplest way to explain how to remove a keloid scar with the use of laser treatment is by imagining a laser moving along your skin, occasionally removing a tiny layer where a scar is, which in turn allows the more natural looking skin beneath to come to the surface.

In some cases, certain lasers can also be used to instigate collagen growth below your skin, which in turn allows your body to heal the scars naturally.

The specific lasers used for [keloid scar treatment](#) include Cynosure lasers and Candela lasers. These lasers are also often used in conjunction with steroid injections, which help make scars flatter and easier to deal with.

### **Keloid scar removal surgery after care**

Post-treatment, you don't really have to worry about complicated or difficult aftercare. Generally, you will simply be told to carefully wash your face, drying gently with a patting technique rather than a wiping technique. Non-sticking bandages will keep antibiotic ointment applied, while keeping your treated skin clean and safe.

In some cases, your doctor will also recommend facial masks or certain medicated creams to help in the healing process. Your body will start to heal your skin within a few days, and you'll report back to the doctor a couple of months later to make sure everything is going okay.

### **Is it for you**

Not everyone is a great candidate for [keloid scar removal](#) by way of laser treatments, however. African-Americans, for instance, can't use lasers for keloid scars treatment. Also, if you have certain skin conditions, including psoriasis or dermatitis, you may not be eligible for laser treatment of keloid scars.

The best way to determine whether you are an ideal candidate for this type of procedure is by speaking with your dermatologist, who can also recommend other possible methods, as well.
